#### I. UNITS OF STUDY:

**Life Science (7th grade):** Chemistry of Life, Plant and Animal Cells, Living Organisms, Ecology, Balance within Ecosystems, Reproduction and Heredity, Health and Diseases, Food webs and Cycles of matter.

**Earth Science (8th grade)**: Properties of Matter, Earth's Crust, Geologic History of Earth, Landforms and Topography, Factors that affect Earth, Earth's Forces, Astronomy and Space Exploration, Pollution and It's Effects.

#### II. GRADES

You earn your grades in the form of percentages, not letter grades. You class grade is divided into two categories: daily activities (80% of your quarter grade) and the quarter exam (20% of your quarter grade). Daily activities may include bell work, class work, homework, vocabulary, quizzes, tests, projects, and laboratory assignments.

## **B.** Test/Quizzes

Chapter tests and Unit tests will be given at the end of each section/unit. Tests are comprehensive covering all the material in a chapter or unit.

## C. Quarter Exams

A Quarterly Exam is required at the end of each nine-week period. It will include all material that was covered throughout the grading period. The exam is worth 20% of the nine-week grade.

#### III. AGENDAS

All students are issued an agenda to record homework. I expect my students to use this valuable organizational tool to record all assignments, upcoming tests, and projects. It is your responsibility to have the agenda daily in class and use it accordingly. Parents are encouraged to check the agenda daily.

#### IV. CLASSROOM RULES

#### V. CLASSROOM PROCEDURES

## A. Entering the Classroom

# B. What to do if you Finish Class Work Early

## **C.** Classroom Discussions

- PLEASE participate.
- I want to hear what you have to say.
- Make all questions and comments <u>relevant</u> to the current discussion.
- If your question is off the topic, write it down and ask later.

## **D.** Getting Your Attention

There may be times when I may need to get everyone's undivided attention so that I may give directions, explanations, answer group questions, etc. When I need everyone to stop talking and pay attention to me: I will say "Class, your attention please" and raise my hand. When you see me raise my hand, you must:

- 1. Raise your hand and keep it up until I put mine down.
- 2. Stop talking and look at me. This should take no more than 10 sec.
- 3. Wait for me to speak.

### E. Moving Around the Classroom

- Stay in your seat during lecture and whole class discussions.
- Sharpening pencils is only allowed during independent work.
- Only one person at a time is allowed at the pencil sharpener.

#### F. Class Dismissal

- Please stay seated until the bell rings.
- I will tell you when it is appropriate to start packing.
